Dashboard Overview

This is the first view shown to a user after logging in. From here users may create a new sweepstakes or edit, audit, and set live existing sweepstakes as well as create and edit users and groups.

At left is the list of promotions currently in the system. To create a new promotion, click “New Sweepstakes” above. To edit, audit or view a report on an existing promotion, right-click on its row in the list and select the respective action from the contextual menu that appears.

To edit or create a user or the group to which they belong, click “Users & Groups” above.

General Section

Copy that appears in left column: This section defines the basic building blocks of a promotion, allowing for such things as automatic generation of the Official Rules and Spread-the-Word pages.

Description:

This required field defines which site and member paper a promotion is associated with. Depending on Administrator login level, a pull-down menu may appear with options to select a target. If an Administrator is logged in at the lowest level, a non-editable value will be automatically placed.

This required field is the end-user viewable title of the promotion. This title will appear across the top of the promotion registration page as well as the target affiliate's contests page.

This required field defines the folder name on the server where this promotion will reside. The name entered must be unique to that server and contain only letters, numbers and underscores (_). Entering a name in this field allows an Administrator to directly publicize the promotion outside of the confines of a given Affiliate by providing a unique URL. For example, if an Administrator logging in at the Cleveland.com level (or below) entered "winCavsTickets" as a Directory Name, the following URL would then be available once the promotion went Live:

This required date entry defines when a promotion that has been approved will automatically switch to “live” and as such be available to the public to enter.

This required date entry defines when a “live” promotion will switch to “ended” and as such no longer be available to the public to enter.

Co-Sponsor Name

This optional field defines the legal name of a co-sponsor, if present. (Note that the principle sponsor is determined automatically by the system based on Administrator login level.) If a value was entered in the “Co-Sponsor Address” field, this field in turn becomes required. If there are multiple co-sponsors, additional fields for their entry can be exposed by clicking the “+ Co-Sponsor” button.

This optional field defines the legal address of a co-sponsor. If a value was entered in the “Co-Sponsor Name” field, this field in turn becomes required. (Note that the principle sponsor is determined automatically by the system based on Administrator login level.)

Description:

Checking this optional field defines the promotion as only being open to people above 18 years of age and will cause an automatic inclusion of an age-screening page to the promotion before a user can enter further information (and gain entry into the promotion). If a user enters a date that resolves to an age below 18, then they will be shown an error page that explains that they are too young to enter the promotion and (assuming their browser accepts cookies) they will be “cookied”, barring them from returning to the age screening page to re-enter a date for as long as they do not clear their cookies.

Is and air trip part of the prize?

Description:

This required field indicates the presence of a prize in the promotion that includes an airline trip. If “yes” is selected, a separate offline rules production and legal approval track is required, as the automatic generation of rules is then prohibited.

This required field defines the total number of prizes to be awarded of a given prize or prize pack in the promotion. In most cases, there will only be one prize given out, such as one copy of the “It’s a Mad Mad Mad Mad World DVD Box Set”. A pack of prizes that is given to one winner is considered a single prize, such as “a ticket each for you and a friend to attend the September 6th Cavs game”. Note that additional sets of prize fields are available by clicking the “+ Prize” button.

This field will appear only if the Administrator has checked that an air trip is part of the prize or if the total computed ARV is greater or equal to \$500. At that point, it will be required for the Administrator to click the “upload” button to navigate to a pre-designed and completed HTML rules page, that is built from the template which can be downloaded by clicking the “download template” link.

Include Spread-the-Word

Checking this optional field will cause the automatic inclusion of a Spread-The-Word page in the promotion. This page would then allow the public to utilize a simple tool to tell their friends about the promotion via today’s most common channels such as email, Facebook, or Twitter.

Copy that appears in left column: This section defines the standard field elements that a sweepstakes entrant will fill out as part of their registration for the promotion.

Description:

This optional field allows the user to indicate the number of children under 18 who are living in their household. Checking the "include" column will cause the field to appear for the registrant to enter. Additionally checking "required" will require the registrant to enter this information as part of their entry into the promotion.

This optional field allows the user to check off which newspapers from the provided list they subscribe to. Checking the “include” column will cause the field to appear for the registrant to enter. Additionally checking “required” will require the registrant to enter this information as part of their entry into the promotion. The list of newspapers that comprise the options for the registrant will be automatically drawn based on the “Promotion Target” that was selected by the administrator in the “General” section of this tool.

Description:

This required field (both for the promotion and for the user to select an answer) allows the user to opt-in to receive additional information from related parties through various channels.

Flexible Questions Section

Copy that appears in left column: This section builds on the Standard Questions section by allowing administrators to create their own questions of various types and define potential answers for a registrant to fill out as part of their registration.

Flexible Questions: Overview

Description:

To create a new question, click “new” to the left, then fill out the appropriate information to define the parameters of the flexible question.

To edit an existing question, hover over its title in the table at left and click on “edit” in the contextual menu that appears.

To disable an existing question, hover over its title in the table at left and click on “disable” in the contextual menu that appears. When a question is disabled, it will not appear for the entrant, but still remains in the Promotion Builder Tool for this promotion.

To re-enable an existing question that has been disabled, first ensure that the “hide disabled questions checkbox is unchecked”, then hover over the question’s title in the table at left and click on “enable” in the contextual menu that appears.

To adjust the order in which the questions are displayed for the registrant as they fill out their registration, hover over a question title in the table at left and click on either the up arrow or the down arrow to move the selected question up or down within the list respectively.

Description:

When creating a Flexible Question, the basic type of the question must first be defined from the following list of options:

Checkboxes: allows entrant to select multiple answers from a defined list that is all visible at once.

Radio buttons: allows entrant to select a single answer from a defined list that is all visible at once.

Pull-down menu: allows entrant to select a single answer from a defined list

Short answer (100 char max): allows entrant to fill in an input field with their own free form answer of not more than 100 characters.

Long answer (2000 char max): allows entrant to fill in an input field with their own free form answer of not more than 2000 characters.

Checkboxes with last field a short answer: allows entrant to select multiple answers from a defined list that is all visible at once with the last answer field a 100 character maximum free form input field.

Radio buttons with last field a short answer: allows entrant to select a single answer from a defined list that is all visible at once with the last answer field a 100 character maximum free form input field.

Promotion Design Section

Copy that appears in left column: This section defines the artistic aspects of a promotion within the confines of the Promotion Builder deployment, allowing an administrator to define such things as basic promotion colors and banner image.

Description:

This design element, which is required for promotion, appears at the top of every page in the promotion. Click “browse” to navigate your local hard-drive to select and upload an image file to the system. The uploaded image must be in one of the following formats: jpg/jpeg, gif, or png (recommended to be without an invisible background). In addition, this image must be exactly 728 pixels wide. The height of this image is optional, but should not be so large as to dominate the page. As this is the main visual element of the promotion, care should be taken in designing this element. Click “browse” to navigate your local hard-drive to select and upload an image file to the system. Care should be taken in designing this element such that the edges of the uploaded image tile well. While there are no maximum dimensions for this image, it is recommended that a tile remain small (100 pixels square or less).

This required image is displayed to the left of the contest information within the contests page at the Promotion Target online affiliate site. It is required to be exactly 150 pixels wide by 95 pixels tall and in jpg format.

This required field defines the single line of introductory text that appears next to the thumbnail image and above the description on the target online affiliate's contests page, (e.g.: "Win Cavs tickets!"). Registrants will click through this title to arrive at the promotion page.

This required field defines a paragraph of HTML text (meaning hyperlinks are allowed to outside content) of no more than 285 characters that give further explanation as to the promotion, (e.g.: "Are you a fan of basketball and live in the Cleveland area? Then enter for your chance to win a pair of tickets to the January 23rd Cleveland Cavaliers game from our friends at (link)superseats.com.") Note that the system will automatically include no purchase necessary and entry deadline information below this field, and as such it should not be duplicated in the Description.

Nightly Reporting Section

Copy that appears in left column: In addition to reporting metrics assessable through the online reporting tool, the system is capable of sending a nightly breakdown of top level information regarding registrations via email.

This section allows system administrators with sufficient credentials to create, edit, and/or delete users (those that can utilize this system) and entities (online affiliates such as “Cleveland.com”, and member papers such as “The Cleveland Plain Dealer” under which users exist).
